**REVIEW**

The 2023 Châteauneuf Du Pape (50% Grenache, 20% Syrah, 20% Mourvèdre, and 10% Cinsault) is classic stuff, with ripe red and black fruits as well as ample peppery garrigue and iron-like nuances. It's medium-bodied, concentrated, has solid tannins, and the charming, forward style of the vintage. This cuvée comes from a mix of pebbly and limestone soils and was partially destemmed, with its élevage in old barrels and concrete tanks. 2,500 cases produced.
