But I wonder if the bottling that arrives in America will be as profound as what I tasted in France? What I tasted was exquisite. It had obviously seen some new oak given the subtle vanillin, smoky character in the fabulously dramatic, earthy, black-fruit-scented, sweet nose. In the mouth the wine displays full body, exquisite depth and richness, as well as fine grip and focus. This cuvee was selected by French wine broker, Alain Corcia. It is not subjected to any fining or filtration either after fermentation or prior to bottling. The 1998 Chateauneuf du Pape Cuvee Prestige* should turn out to be sensational. A dark ruby/purple color is followed by scents of smoked herbs, grilled meats, spice box, licorice, and abundant red and black fruits. It is full-bodied, moderately tannic, with a chewy texture, and an impressive finish. It should drink well for two decades.

The expansively flavored 1999 Chateauneuf du Pape Cuvee Prestige Tete de Cru reveals a big nose of cinnamon and smoky black cherries, an opulent, voluptuous style, full body, sweet glycerin, outstanding purity, and a seamless mouthfeel. It is a gorgeous wine to drink over the next 7-10 years.

The superb 2000 Chateauneuf du Pape Cuvee Prestige Tete de Cru boasts a deep ruby/purple color in addition to a sumptuous perfume of figs, plums, prunes, and jammy black cherry fruit. It offers a large, voluminous mouthfeel, an unctuous texture, full body, and a heady, concentrated, blockbuster finish. A beautiful wine with low acidity, sweet tannin, and gobs of glycerin as well as fruit, it should drink well for 10-15 years.

Totally closed and in need of considerable aeration to reveal itself, the 2000 Chateauneuf du Pape La Lettre a Louis Arnaud should be forgotten for 3-4 years. Its deep ruby color includes purple nuances. Closed aromatically, revealing hints of creme de cassis and black cherries, this deep, full-bodied 2000 cuts a broad swath across the palate with considerable depth and concentration. While tannic as well as broodingly backward, it is potentially the finest wine made at Cabrieres since their legendary 1961. Anticipated maturity: 2005-2020.

2001 Cabrieres Chateauneuf du Pape la Lettre A Louis Arnaud

The micro-cuvee of 2001 Chateauneuf du Pape La Lettre a Louis Arnaud comes from extremely old vines. Tightly-knit as well as dense, it is chewy, with loads of glycerin, a deep plum/ruby color, and sweet aromas of black cherry liqueur, chocolate, and flowers. Unctuous, thick, juicy, and moderately tannic, it will drink well between 2006-2020.

The basic cuvee of 2006 Chateauneuf du Pape reveals jammy black cherry notes intermixed with some smoke, herbs, loamy soil, tar, and pepper. It has a sort of gamey black fruit character in the mouth, medium body, soft tannins, and adequate acidity. Drink it over the next decade.
