CHATEAU CABRIERES

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50% Grenache, 30% Syrah, 10% Mourvèdre, 10% Cinsault, (1960s), destemmed, 3-week vinification, aged 90% vat, 10% large barrel 6 months, fined, filtered, 30,000 b

Mostly full red colour; broad, brewed nature to the bouquet, comes with a meaty, dark fruit angle, licorice: is well-filled, a touch powdery. There is mild smoke on top of the tight black fruit; has a solid constitution. A prune flavour emerges at the end as the Grenache works back into the front rank. The Grenache is ripe, evolving notes. It persists quite powerfully. From mid-2012. 2021-23 Oct 2010
